

Tri Star Charitable Pro-Am Adverse Weather Policy

In the event of adverse weather, the following policy will apply:

- 1) If the golf course is unplayable or conditions do not permit play to begin, the event will be cancelled, and the cocktail reception will begin at 3pm in the main dining room of the club.
- 2) If play begins and adverse weather or course conditions halt play to the extent that all groups are unable to complete nine holes, the event will be cancelled. The cocktail reception will begin at 3pm in the main dining room of the club.
- 3) If play is suspended after all teams have completed at least nine holes, the winners will be determined by the best score in relation to par for the greatest number of holes that all teams have been able to complete. For example, if all teams have completed 12 holes, the tournament will be scored based on scores through 12 holes. In this case, there will be no shootout and the top four teams will receive prizes. Ties will be broken for all four places by the golf professional's score to par through the number of holes completed. If a winner cannot be determined by the golf professional's score, the second tiebreaker will be determined by the greatest number of holes played under par by the golf professional. The third tiebreaker will be a blind draw. The cocktail reception will begin as soon as possible following the completion of play.
- 4) Prizes in the golf professional competition will be awarded only if the entire field has completed at least nine holes. In this case, ties will be broken for all five places by the golf professional's score to par through the number of holes completed. If a winner cannot be determined by the golf professional's score, the second tiebreaker will be determined by the greatest number of holes played under par by the golf professional. The third tiebreaker will be a blind draw.

Proceeds from the 2023 Tri Star Charitable Pro Am have been committed to several charitable organizations in our community. In the event of a rain-out, we will have incurred the same expenses had the event been completed in its entirety. As would be the case with a fully completed event, entry fees / donations will first pay expenses and the remainder will fund our charitable projects.
